FLORAL PAPER STAMPING



MATERIALS

- Medium Oval Platter
 - Sponge
- Table Paper • Pen • Scissors
 - Fan Brush
 - Liner Brush
- Paints: 5, 16, 67, 17, 27, 66

TIPS


- For best results, please read all instructions before beginning project.
- Refer to photo for design placement.
- Use a tile or a palette to brush the colors onto paper shapes.

Color Me Mine

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Draw shapes like these on a strip of table paper and cut them out. They don't have to be copied exactly. They simply need to represent three sizes of flower petals and a single leaf. Make sure to leave some extra paper to hold on to at the end of each shape.

2. Wipe the bisque down with a damp sponge to remove ceramic dust.

3. Start with the largest flower petal shape # 1. Place it on a tile or a paint palette and cover one side of it with bright pink # 5 using a Fan brush. Place it painted side down anywhere on the platter and apply some pressure with fingertips to transfer the paint onto the bisque. Remove paper shape to see the result.

4. Repeat this process to build the shape of each flower with this paper stamping technique. Position each flower petal in such a way that the extra paper is in the center of the flower. Flower petals can slightly overlap each other placed around the center of each flower they form.

5. Paint the medium petal shape # 2 with light pink # 16. Stamp each petal around the center of each flower forming a second layer of flower petals for each flower.

6. Repeat the same process with the small petal shape # 3. Use white # 67.

7. Complete each flower by adding a few small dots in the center. Use the back of a liner brush handle dipped in # 66.

8. Stamp some leaves all around available white space using the leaf shape # 4 and blend of # 17 and # 27.

9. Add some stems using a liner brush loaded with green # 27.
