- Flower Patterns (See last 2 pages)
 - Tissue Paper
 - Pencil
- Dark Water-Based Marker
- Sponge

- 92 – Ghostly Grape

- 59 – Turquoise
- 17 – Margarita
- 31 – Licorice



Color Me Mine

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over the entire bisque to remove dust and contaminants.
2. Trace the flowers from the pattern sheet (see last 2 pages) onto the tissue paper with a pencil.
3. Place the tissue paper patterns on the pottery and trace over the lines with a dark water-based marker.
4. Paint 2-3 coats of Coral Reef, Ghostly Grape, and Turquoise on the flower petals. Let each coat dry completely.
5. Paint 2-3 coats of Margarita on the Coral Reef and Ghostly Grape flower middles. Let each coat dry completely.
6. Paint 2-3 coats of Orange Juice on the Turquoise flower middles. Let each coat dry completely.
7. Paint 2-3 coats of Kiwi on the leaves. Let each coat dry completely.
8. Paint 2-3 coats of Licorice on the eyes and nose. Let each coat dry completely.
9. With a liner brush and Licorice, carefully outline the flowers, leaves, and add swirls.
10. Using the back of the pencil like a stamp, make dots with Orange Juice and Licorice to fill in the blank spots. Let dry.
11. Clear glaze then stilt and fire to cone 06.




