MATERIALS

Medium Oval French Bread Plate

#6 Fan Brush
#1 Short Liner Brush
Writer Bottles (4)
Medium Writer Bottle Tips (4)
Pencil

CMM14 - Gum Drop
CMM59 - Turquoise
CMM27 - Kiwi
CMM55 - Sea Mist
CMM104 - Orange Juice
CMM68 - Beachcomber
CMM31 - Licorice

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe a damp sponge over the entire piece to remove dust and contaminants.
2. Apply an even amount of Orange Juice on the baby's feet and print them onto the center of the plate. Apply even pressure and lift the feet straight up to avoid smearing.
3. Fill 4 writer bottles, each with one of the following colors: Gum Drop, Turquoise, Kiwi, and Sea Mist.
4. Lightly pencil the child's name and age.
5. With a liner brush, carefully trace over the lettering.
6. Lightly pencil the tropical leaf designs around the prints. Use the attached pattern sheet for inspiration.
7. Trace over and color in the leaf patterns with the Gum Drop, Turquoise, Kiwi, and Sea Mist.
8. Using the back of the pencil like a stamp, add Beachcomber dot accents around the leaves.
9. Lastly, add Licorice dots around the rim of the plate with the back of the pencil.

TIPS

- Allow paint to dry between coats.
- Wash brush between colors.
- For the best prints, apply the color as evenly as possible. Too thin and your print will not show all the way. Too thick and the print will not show the texture of the skin.
- After you have evenly applied the color, gently place the foot onto the pottery. Make sure to apply pressure to each toe and the arch of the foot for a nice, balanced print.
