DB21427 Coupe Salad Plate
Medium Brush
Small Brush
Silkscreen Medium
Small Dish for Mixing Goo
Optional Screen Squeegee
NCR Character Pattern
Gingham Silkscreen












- 1 Put several tablespoons of Gecko Green into your small mixing cup and apply a pinch or two of Silkscreen Medium. Stir up and let sit for 5 minutes. Stir again. You're looking for the consistency of pudding, if it's too thick, add more Gecko Green paint and stir until you're getting the pudding consistency.
2. Use either your screen squeegee or finger apply the gingham to the background of the plate with the Gecko Green paste. Allow to dry.
3. Either use the NCR pattern and a pen to apply the limes or you can freehand them making circles.
4. Apply 3 coats of Kiwi to the limes.
5. Use your detail brush to apply 2-3 coats of Kiwi for edges and lines.
6. Use the stick end of the brush and dip it into Kiwi , then tap the handle down on the plate to apply the dots.

TIPS

- Use light pressure with your detail brush to get skinnier lines.
- Be generous with the paint to get the most even color.
