MATERIALS

DB21427 Coupe Salad Plate
Detail Brush
Fan Brush
Skeleton Pattern
NCR Paper or Tissue Paper

COLORS

CMM 39 - Blue Green
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 14 - Gumdrop

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start by painting the entire front of the plate with 3 coats of Blue Green. Allow that to dry thoroughly
2. Once the background is dry, use either NCR paper or the tissue transfer technique to put the skeleton pattern on your plate.
3. Use your detail brush to apply 1-2 heavy coats of Gumdrop for the bones of the skeleton.
4. Finally, use your detail brush to add the eyes, nose, and mouth on the skeleton with 1 heavy coat of Licorice.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- Don't be too stressed about the face being perfect, we are going for cute and quirky
- The harder you push down on the brush, the thicker the line will be. So, on the face keep the brush straight and don't press down to get the finest lines.
