HALLOWEEN KAWAII GHOST PITCHER



MATERIALS

TC4423 Pitcher 2 Liter
Detail Brush
Fan Brush
Medium Brush
Character Patterns
NCR Paper or Tissue Paper

COLORS

CMM 2 - Stonewashed
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 101 - Fresh Heather
CMM 69 - Orange Juice
CMM 14 - Gumdrop
CMM 16 - Chiffon



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start by painting the outside of the pitcher with 3 coats of Chiffon using a fan brush.
2. While the outside is drying, you can paint the inside and the top rim with 3 coats of Carrot Juice.
3. Once the pink is dry, paint the handle of the pitcher with 3 coats of Fresh Heather using a medium brush.
4. Allow everything to dry before tracing on your character patterns.
5. Fill in your Ghosts using a detail brush and 3 coats of either Snowflake or Gumdrop (or any of the other colors you like).
6. Use the stick end of your brush and dip it into your Carrot Juice paint. Then, stamp it on the pitcher to make a dot. Repeat until you have the desired amount of orange dots.
7. Repeat step 6 using Stonewashed and Fresh Heather.
8. Finally, add the faces and details to the ghosts using your detail brush and Licorice paint.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- Don't be too stressed about the ghosts being perfect, we are going for cute and quirky.
- The harder you push down on the brush, the thicker the line will be. So, on the details keep the brush straight and don't press down to get the finest lines.
- If you want all your dots to be the same size, dip the stick into the paint every time you dot down. That keeps them all uniform.
