# HALLOWEEN TREAT BOWL



## MATERIALS

TC5530 Salad Bowl 10x14  
Detail Brush  
Fan Brush  
Character Patterns  
Word Pattern  
NCR Paper or Tissue Paper  
Sanding Block or Sponge

## COLORS

CMM 2 - Stonewashed  
CMM 67 - Snowflake  
CMM 31 - Licorice  
CMM 101 - Fresh Heather  
CMM 69 - Carrot Juice  
CMM 12 - Mocha Java  
CMM 70 - Star Dust  
CMM 14 - Gumdrop  
CMM 46 - Sunny Side Up  
CMM 39 - Blue Green  
CMM 104 Orange Juice

## INSTRUCTIONS


1. Start by painting the outside of the bowl with 3 coats of Orange Juice using a fan brush.
2. While the outside is drying, you can paint the inside of the bowl with 3 coats of Gumdrop.
3. Once the orange is dry, use either NCR paper or tissue transfer technique to apply the "Happy Halloween" pattern to the outside of the bowl.
4. We used a detail brush to paint on 3 coats on each of the letters. We used just Licorice for the word "happy" and for the Halloween we alternated between the Chiffon, Fresh Heather, Stonewashed, Blue Green, and Gumdrop.
5. We used Orange Juice for the pumpkin on the outside and Snowflake for the ghost. We did three coats on each using the detail brush. We will apply the details on those when we do the ones on the inside.
6. When the inside is dry, apply your patterns.
7. Fill in your Ghosts, Skulls, and Candy Corn using a detail brush and 3 coats of Snowflake.
8. Use your detail brush again to fill in the pumpkins and bottom of the candy corn with 3 coats of Carrot Juice.
9. Then, use your detail brush with Mocha Java to add one heavy coat for the stem on the pumpkins.
10. To fill in the bats, use your detail brush and 3 coats of Star Dust.
11. To finish the candy corn, use 3 coats of Sunnyside Up on your detail brush.
12. Then, fill in the spider body with 3 coats of Licorice.
13. Finally, add the faces and details to the characters, such as the legs for the spiders, and the detail on the bat wings using Licorice.

## TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- Don't be too stressed about the characters being perfect, we are going for cute and quirky.
- The harder you push down on the brush, the thicker the line will be. So, on the details keep the brush straight and don't press down to get the finest lines.
