

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start out by painting the nose, cheeks, and hands with 3 coats of Beachcomber.
2. Use a liner brush to paint the stripes on the pants. We did 2 generous coats on each stripe.
3. Next, paint 2 coats of London Fog to the beard. After the grey loses its shine use your medium brush to add heavy highlights on the raised parts of the beard using Snowflake.
4. Use your medium brush to paint the shirt and the patch with 3 coats of Battleship.
5. To paint the boots, belt, and stitching on the patch, apply 3 coats of Star Dust.
6. Next we are going to work on the hat. You can first plan out your stripes using your water based marker.
7. We then used Red Hot to paint the brim of the hat with 3 coats.
8. Paint the rest of your stripe with either London Fog, Battleship, or Star Dust. If you want the base of the stripe to be white you can leave it unpainted.
9. For the dots on a stripe, you can dip the handle of the brush into paint and stamp it on the stripe. If you want the dots to be the same size, dip into the paint before each dot.
10. Finally you can add cross hatching lines in a darker color on a stripe to add some texture.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- The harder you press on the brush the heavier the line will be. So light even pressure if you want thin lines.

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
