INSTRUCTIONS

These eggs look wonderful in any of the crystal specialty glazes! Here are a few hints:

- This piece will not be dipped in clear glaze, so make sure to cover all of the pottery.
- The pebbles will move and melt and may not stay exactly where you put them.
- If you have pebbles on the bottom of the piece, they might drip into feet that will keep your piece from standing steady. So, avoid pebbles on the bottom of the piece.
- Use the handle of your brush to stir up any crystals at the bottom of the jar before you paint.
- Apply 2 coats all over then check with the staff to see if you need another layer.
- These paints are organic in nature, each jar of the same color may have slight differences. Each piece painted with the same color will come out looking slightly different. It's what makes them unique.

The colors listed on page one are in the same order you see them in the photo. Left to right starting on the top row.
